Whereas, the said Nattie Maxwell

in and by my certain property

note in writing, of even date with

these presents, am well and truly indebted to Piedmont Lumber Company

in the full and just sum of Five Hundred and Thirty-Five and 82/100 Dollars  
 to be paid in full, to wit, Sixty-five (\$65.00) Dollars on the 15th  
 of May a 19 1932 and Sixty-five (\$65.00) Dollars on the 15th  
 day of each and every consecutive month thereafter until paid  
 in full  
 with interest thereon from maturity

at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid  
 until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past  
 due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose  
 this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% per cent (one per cent)  
 besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the  
 hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured  
 under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

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in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better  
 securing the payment thereof to the said Piedmont Lumber Company,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum  
 of Three Dollars, to the said Nattie Maxwell,  
 in hand well and truly paid by the said Piedmont Lumber Company

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof  
 is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Piedmont Lumber Company, its successors and assigns,  
 all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,  
 Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the east side of Pinckney  
 Street, in the City of Greenville, being designated as lot no. 5  
 of the original property, according to a plat of said property  
 made by L. M. Furman, Jr., and having the following lines  
 and bounds:

Beginning at the Ellison corner on Pinckney Street, and  
 running thence along the said Ellison line, N. 58-33 & E. 55-1  
 feet to a point in the line of the said Ellison property;  
 thence N. 34-30 W. 48-3 feet, thence along the right line of lots  
 4 and 5 of the original property S. 57-26 W. 125-5 feet to a  
 point, joint corner of said lots 4 and 5, on Pinckney street,  
 thence along the line of Pinckney street, S. 15-20 & 46 feet to the  
 beginning corner.
