*get that lot of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the town of Sumner, on Snow House Street, adjoining lot of Bert Prince, and having the following lines and bounds;*  
*Beginning at the corner of Bert Prince on Snow House Street and thence thence with the line 58 feet to J. H. Burnett's corner; thence with the line 114 feet; thence a right angle 58 feet to Bert Prince's line; thence with the line 114 feet to the beginning corner, being part of the same lot of land conveyed to the by deed by J. W. Martin, the deed recorded in Vol. 241, page 90.*
