I, Frances Hodges Vaughn, of Greenville, S.C.

SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I the said Frances Hodges Vaughn,

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with

these presents, A.D. 1932, well and truly indebted to J. F. Helborn,

in the full and just sum of Four Hundred, twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$412.50) to be paid as follows; Twenty-five dollars of the principal each month beginning October first 1932, and a like amount on the first and every month thereafter until the total amount is paid in full.

at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10 per cent.

besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Frances Hodges Vaughn

for and in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said J. F. Helborn

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said Frances Hodges Vaughn

in hand well and truly paid by the said J. F. Helborn,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. F. Helborn, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate on the West side of Jones Ave. in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as lot no. 9 on the plat of the property of Parrish, Gower & Martin as shown on plat made by Dalton & Rives and recorded in the R. M. B. office for Greenville County S. C. in plat book "A" at page 176, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Jones Ave., which iron pin is 79.8 feet south of the Southwest corner of the intersection of Jones and Pearl Avenues, also joint corner of lots nos. 9 and 10; thence along joint of said lots, N. 89-12 W. 175 feet to an iron pin on the East side of a 15 foot alley; thence along the East side of said alley S. 0-48 W. 61 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots nos. 8 and 9; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 89-12 E. 175 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Jones Avenue; thence with the said Jones Ave., N. 0-48 E. 61 feet to the beginning.

This mortgage is junior to the one held by South Carolina Securities Co. for \$3750.00 on which has been paid \$112.37.

Being the same lot conveyed to me by J. F. Helborn, by deed, dated September 1, 1932 and this mortgage is given for a part of purchase price.
