 to be paid as follows and deficit: One hundred fifty dollars due

 after date and two hundred dollars three years after date
 with interest thereon from date

at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid interestually
 until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past

W. H. Smith from A. B. Hughes and is recorded in the
 R. M. & C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. N. N., page
 662, and has the following metes and bounds, to wit;
 beginning at a Hickory 3x by two Hickories and
 runs thence N. 12° W. 1.78 chs. to large P. C.; thence S.
 14° 15' W. 13.40 chs. to stone 3x4m; thence S. 31° 30' E. 6.00
 to stake in road; thence N. 57° E. 9.00 to stone in road;
 thence S. 86° E. 25.40 chs. to stake 2x in creek; thence
 down creek S. 36° 15' E. 5.00 chs.; thence N. 86° E. 2.35 chs.
 to stake on old line; thence with said old line N.
 13° 15' E. 13.80 to stone 2x; thence N. 75° 1/2 W. 11.90 to stone
 on creek; thence down creek S. 82° 30' E. 3.26 chs. to
 stone 3x4m; thence N. 80° W. 13-20 to stone 3x4m. thence
