Whereas, I, the said G. A. Poore

in the full and just sum of \$150.00 Hundred Fifty Dollars
 to be paid three years from our date, which is 1932 to be paid on
 January 1st of 1934, and the right to me to anticipate the
 payment of all or any part of said note before the due date of same
 with interest thereon from the date

at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent besides all cost and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

All that certain piece of land situate lying and being in Bala Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina containing twenty-five acres, more or less, adjoining land now owned formerly by Stephen M. Goldsmith, trustee of S. S. Cottenham, et al, and the same tract of land conveyed to W. H. Price, deceased, by Elijah S. May, by deed bearing date November 2nd, 1902, and recorded in the H. H. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 477, page 556.

Also, all that other tract of land situate in Bala Township, County and State aforesaid, adjoining the above-described tract and containing three acres, more or less, adjoining lands now owned (or formerly) by A. H. Skinner et al and is the same tract of land conveyed to W. H. Price, deceased by Stephen M. Goldsmith, by deed bearing date April 22nd, 1903, and recorded in the H. H.
