with interest thereon from October, 1932
at the rate of 1 per cent per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past
due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose

is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Feb. 1st, 1884, all that certain piece of land, lot or tract of land, lying, situate and being in the State and County aforesaid, located on the Fort Street road, and being described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the Branch at 4th Street corner, and running up said branch to the line 11.16 chain to a stake; thence 11.26 E. 4.40 to a stone; thence 11.81-30 E. 10.78 to an iron pin in center of Fort Street road; thence along center of the Fort Street road, S.11-30 E. 16.00 to an iron pin on Robert line; thence S.67 W. 3.24 to stone; thence S.82-18-4.92; thence N. 82 W. 14.52 to the beginning corner, and containing 46.656 acres more or less.

It is understood and agreed between the Mortgagor and
