Whereas, I the said

in and by my certain day of July note in writing, of even date with

these presents, am well and truly indebted to *Maurie H. Fulmer*in the full and just sum of *One Thousand Hundred Ninety Six and 48/100 Dollars*to be paid in monthly installments of \$100.00 (12.50) Dollars
beginning on the 9th day of December A.D. 1932.with interest thereon from *July*

at the rate of 8 per cent per annum, to be computed and paid monthly as a part of the above mentioned

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past

due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose
this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Ten per cent (10%)*

besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the

hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured

under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said *Carrie Lee Baldwin*in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
securing the payment thereof to the said *Maurie H. Fulmer* Satisfied and CANCELLED OF *July 21*according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum
of Three Dollars, to *The Clerk* the said *Carrie Lee Baldwin* *Dee J. Gaskins* R. M. C. FOR GREENVILLE COUNTY, S.C.in hand well and truly paid by the said *Maurie H. Fulmer* AT *3:40 O'CLOCK P.M.* *79369*at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Maurie H. Fulmer, her heirs and assigns: All that certain piece of land situate, lying and being in Newberry County and State aforesaid, and described as follows: Beginning at an iron gin on the line of a tract of land containing 14 and 66/100 acres, and running thence S. 5-45 W. 3.00 to a gully; thence S. 30 W. 1.00 to a bend in said gully; thence S. 75-45 W. 202.0 to a bend; thence N. 89 W. 1.45 to a bend; thence N. 68 W. 1.00 to an iron gin in the Laurens Road; thence along Laurens Road to Taddo's corner; thence with Taddo's line N. 44-15 E. 10.62 to a line on the first described tract, or adjoining tract; thence with line of same tract of land N. 61-45 W. 2.20 to the beginning corner, containing two and 6/10 acres, more or less.

Also that other tract of land in the County and State aforesaid, and described as follows: Beginning at an iron gin on the line of the 14 and 66/100 acre tract described in due to Maurie H.
