with interest thereon from date

at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

Green at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

May H. Green, Perry H. Green, Grady J. Green, Hubert S. Green, Eva L. Green and Unice M. Green; all that certain tract of parcel of land situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, which springs Township, on the Bunccombe Road, where it now lies, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the Bunccombe Road at intersection of Brushy Creek Road and run thence N. 67 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 13.10 chs. to a stone in the center of old railroad bed; thence along right-of-way of Southern Railroad N. 64 E. 34. 90 chs. to a stone in center of old railroad track; thence S 11 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 21.70 chs. to a stone on the south side of road; thence N. 78 21. 8.20 chs. to a pin on the North edge of the road; thence S. 79 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 16. 98 chs. to the beginning corner, containing forty-three and six-tenths (43.60) acres, more or less, as per survey made by H.
