SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I the said L. O. Patterson,

in and by my certain promissory

note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, S. C., a corporation having a place of business in the City of Greenville, S. C., in the full and just sum of fourteen hundred and eighty-eight and 76/100 dollars (\$1488.76) to be paid on the fifth day of July, 1933.

with interest thereon from this date

at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of fifty dollars,

besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said L. O. Patterson,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said bank

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said L. O. Patterson,

in hand well and truly paid by the said bank

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, S. C., all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in said State and County, on the main ridge of Paris Mountain, containing 54 1/4 acres, more or less, being the same on which my summer home is situate, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: beginning at a stake on the east side of Thompson Road, where the south boundary line of Lot 74 of Section "A", of the Paris Mountain Land Co. property strikes said road, as shown on blue print filed in office of Register of Mesne Conveyances for said County in Deed Book "DDD", page 902, on July 21, 1906 (said stake being near a pine stump and a post oak, opposite to Lot 26 on said plat), and running thence S. 81 1/4 E. 330 feet to a stake 3x on line of H. C. Markley place, thence along that line N. 3 E. 240 feet to a stone 3x, Markley corner; thence N. 46 E. 1188 feet to a pine stump; thence N. 16 W. 1188 feet to a stone; thence N. 56 W. 330 feet to a hickory 3xnm; thence S. 74 W. 1320 feet to a stake; thence S. 16 E. 1320 feet to a stone and iron pipe; thence S. 3 degrees, 06 minutes W. 587 1/2 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 87 deg., 51 minutes E. 55 feet to a pine stump; thence (following same course) S. 87 degrees, 51 minutes E. 31 feet to an iron pipe on the west side of Thompson Avenue; thence along said avenue to the beginning corner. Part of this land was conveyed to me by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated October 19, 1918, and recorded in said office in Book 52, page 249; the remainder by Paris Mountain-Caesar's Head Co. by deed dated Jan. 20, 1926, recorded in Book 121, page 102.
