in and by May certain promissory note in writing of even date with this note in writing, of even date with

these presents, am well and truly indebted to The Atlantic Joint Stock Land Bank of Raleigh, a corporation "existing pursuant to the Act of Congress entitled 'The Federal Farm Act', with its purpose of assisting the farmers in producing, marketing, and selling their products, One Thousand and One Hundred and Sixty Four Dollars and 00/100th Cents, in full and just sum of, to be paid in four annual installments of Three hundred and 30/100th Dollars each, first installment due April 1st 1940 and annually according to the following instalments to become due and payable at the first day of April of each year thereafter until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due of the said note and to be payable as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection of said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THAT,

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Atlantic Joint Stock Land Bank of Raleigh:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Butler Township, containing fifteen and forty seven hundredths (15.47) acres, to be the same more or less, being known as tract number five (5) of the subdivision of the C. R. Elliott farm, according to plat prepared by St. J. Vile, Surveyor, on March 23, 1937, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center of the road leading to the air port, said beginning point being the northwestern corner of tract number six (6) in the division aforesaid, in the line of the J. S. Southern lands, and runs three North 25 degrees 27 minutes West 307 feet to an iron pin, thence South 74 degrees West crossing a small branch 500 feet to an iron pin on the bank of another branch which intersects said small branch, thence up said branch to a stone, P. T. Watson's line, thence along said P. T. Watson's line North 84 degrees 10 minutes East 709.6 feet to an iron pin, the northwestern corner of tract number four (4) in the division aforesaid, thence along the southwestern line of tract number four as aforesaid bearing 19 degrees W minutes East 887 feet to a point in the center of the road leading to the air port, a common corner between tracts four (4), seven (7) and six (6) in the division as aforesaid, thence along the center line of said road leading to the air port South 67 degrees West 403 feet to the place of beginning.

It is further expressly covenanted, understood and agreed that this mortgage and the note and/or notes which it secures are executed and delivered for the purpose of securing the balance purchase price money for the lands and property hereinbefore described.
