Phillips - All that ~~other~~ ^(A) tract of land lying, situated and being in State and County aforesaid and in Butler Township and more fully described as follows: Beginning at a stone 3x1 in Mrs. Lora L. Howell's field, thence N. 20 E. 2.60 to a poplar on Rocky Creek; thence N. 88 1/2 E. 2.10 with Rocky Creek; thence N. 10 E. 6.06 with Rocky Creek to junction with Brushy Creek; thence up Brushy Creek to ditch; thence S. 88 E. 2.10 with ditch; thence S. 39 1/2 E. 1.83 to head of ditch; thence S. 6 1/4 E. 14.26 to stone 3x0; thence S. 10 E. 8.96 to stone 3x0 on Spartanburg Road; thence with Spartanburg road to stone 3x0; thence S. 66 1/4 W. 8/15 to stone 3x0; thence N. 31 1/4 W. 11.33 to beginning stone and containing 35 acres more or less and adjoining the lands of Lora L.
