WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Ansel Ailewine*
in and by *my* certain *Promissory* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

L.A. Jones
in the full and just sum of *Two Thousand (\$2000.00)*
Dollars, to be paid *One year after date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of _____ per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *annually in full* until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note shall become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
reue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent. of the amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will
more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I* the said *Ansel Ailewine*
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *L.A. Jones*

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *Ansel Ailewine*
in hand well and truly paid by the said *L.A. Jones*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said *L.A. Jones*, the following described property:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate,
lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South
Carolina in Chick Springs Township on the National High-
way and near Taylors, S.C. and having the following
metes and bounds according to a plat of the proper-
ty of Claude Shockley dated October 31, 1922, and recorded
in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F"
at page 89 - to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of said Nat-
ional Highway at corner of lot # 18 and running thence with
line of lot # 18 due south 386 feet 386 feet to pin on right of-
way of P. & N. Railroad; thence with said right of-way in a
southwesterly direction 50.5 feet to pin; thence N. 10. 30 W. 403
feet to pin on the south side of said National Highway;
thence along the south side of said National Highway in
an easterly direction 119.9 feet to the beginning corner.
Said lot being composed of lot nos. 19, 19A, 20 and 20A
of said subdivision of the Claude E. Shockley property accord-
ing to the plat of same recorded in Plat Book "F" at Page 89 in
the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County and being the same lots
conveyed to the mortgagor herein by Claude E. Shockley by
deed dated November 9, 1922, recorded in Deed Book 87 at Page
