AMORTIZATION MORTGAGE

E.W. KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

G. A. Poore (also known as Guy A. Poore) _____ of Greenville _____ County and State aforesaid, hereinafter called first party, whether one or more, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, First party is indebted to the Land Bank Commissioner, acting pursuant to Part 3 of the Act of Congress approved May 12, 1933, known as the Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933, hereinafter called second party, as evidenced by a certain promissory note, of even date herewith, for the principal sum of ~~Six Thousand and 43 cents and 00 mill~~ (\$600.00) Dollars, payable to the order of the second party, together with interest from the date of said note on the principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid, at the rate of ~~Five and 5/100 per centum per annum,~~ #63 the first payment of interest being due and payable on the 1st day of December, 1933, and thereafter interest being due and payable ~~quarterly~~ ~~on the 1st day of July~~ ~~annually~~, said principal sum being due and payable in ~~ten (10)~~ equal, successive, annual installments of ~~Sixty and 00 mill~~ (\$60.00) Dollars each, and a final installment of ~~one mill~~ (\$-----) Dollars, the first installment of said principal being due and payable on the 1st day of December, 1937, and thereafter the remaining installments of principal being due and payable annually until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full; all of which and such other terms, conditions, and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, unto second party, his successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

All that tract or parcel of land containing fifty four and five tenths (54.5) acres in Bates Township, Greenville County & C., known as the Guy A. Poore place located on Tubbs Mountain Road, 2 1/2 miles from Travellers Rest on waters of Tubbs Mountain Creek; bounded on the north by East of Frank Hunt, east lands of East W. G. Powers, south, by W. O. Glenn, Hampton Glenn and Howard Runion, and on west by lands of Pease Hunt; having the following courses and distances, according to survey and plat by R. E. Dalton, Surveyor, 1933.


Beginning at an iron pin in center of bridge over branch on Tubbs Mountain Road, corner of Runion; thence with the line North 65 deg. 15 min. East 588 feet to iron pin; thence South 21 deg. 10 min. East 530 feet to a stone; thence South 89 deg. 40 min. East 418 feet to stone; thence North 56 deg. 30 min. East 1480 feet to white oak stump on branch; thence North 34 deg. 20 min. East 162 feet with Tubbs Branch; thence North 6 deg. 30 min. West 172 feet to iron pin; thence with the branch North 60 deg. 30 min. West 700 feet to iron pin; thence with branch North 16 deg. West 302 feet to iron pin; thence South 54 deg. 15 min. West 436 feet to iron pin; thence North 2 deg. 15 min. E. 384 feet to a stone; thence South 101 deg. 15 min. West 1040 feet to a stone on Tubbs Mountain Road; thence the road the line, South 15 deg. 10 min. West 1060 feet to beginning, being the same conveyed to G. A. Poore by E. Youmans, Master.

A copy of the plat of the above described land is now on file with the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, Columbia, South Carolina.

The debt secured by this Mortgage which is recorded in Mortgage #45 in the Register, now said in full, I, the undersigned, Mortgagor & Co-signer, the owner and holder of said Mortgage and of the Note thereby secured pursuant to the Act of Congress known as Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation Act, by and through The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, as its agent and attorney-in-fact pursuant to the Act of Congress known as Farm Credit Act of 1935, do hereby declare said Mortgage satisfied and the debt thereby forever discharged.
