NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, unto second party, his successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

acres, known as the "Parker Place," in Austin Township, of Greenville County, South Carolina, located on the Pelham Road, two miles Northeast of Mauldin, South Carolina, on waters of Gilders Creek, and now in possession of Annie Ruth Parker, bounded on North by lands of A. B. King; on the East by lands of W. Verdin; on the South by lands of J. S. Smith, and on the West by lands of Tillman Mahaffey. Said tract of land is particularly described according to a plat prepared by W. S. Baldwin, Surveyor, December 5, 1919, as follows, to-wit:
