AMORTIZATION MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That

J. W. Hill, Esq., attorney for Plaintiff, and James W. Hill, Secretary
of Greenville County and State aforesaid hereinafter called first party, whether one or more, SEND GREETINGS:
WHEREAS, First party is indebted to the Land Bank Commissioner, acting pursuant to Part 3 of the Act of Congress approved May 12, 1933, known as the Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933, hereinafter called second party, as evidenced by a certain promissory note, of even date herewith, for the principal sum of ~~Eighteen Thousand Dollars~~ ^{Twenty-five Dollars} (\$18,25.00) Dollars, payable to the order of the second party, together with interest from the date of said note on the principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid, at the rate of ~~Five (5%)~~ per centum per annum, the first payment of interest being due and payable on the ~~1st~~ day of ~~October~~, 1934, and thereafter interest being due and payable annually; said principal sum being due and payable in ~~12~~ equal, successive, annual installments of ~~One thousand five hundred dollars~~ (\$1,500.00) Dollars each, and a final installment of ~~Fourty-six and no/100~~ (\$46.00) Dollars, the first installment of said principal being due and payable on the ~~1st~~ day of ~~November~~, 1932, and thereafter the remaining installments of principal being due and payable annually until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full; all of which and such other terms, conditions, and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN THAT first party, in consideration of the debt as aforesaid by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, unto second party, his successors and assigns, the following described land, to wit:

all that tract of land bounded by one hundred eighty-two feet 8 1/100 & 182.82 acres in Fairview Township, Greenville County, S.C., bounded on the North by Turkeyfield Place, located on the head of the Mountain Branch Road, 1/4 miles south of Fork Shoals, running across of Reedy River, beginning on the North by lands of E. A. Parker and Son's, on the South boundary of Reedy River, and along the West by Reedy River, having the following boundaries and distances, a copy of which is to survey and plat by J. W. Rydele, Surveyor, and recorded in the office of the Clerk of Court of Greenville County, having the following boundaries and distances:

Beginning at a stake N. 0° 45' E. 100.00 feet from corner land, running thence North 53 degrees 10 minutes East 100.00 chains to a stake; thence North 2 degrees 30 minutes East 4.77 chains to iron pin; thence North 23 degrees 30 minutes East 3.60 chains to iron pin; thence North 27 degrees East 4.85 chains to iron pin; thence North 51 degrees East 4.04 chains to stake; thence North 35 degrees 30 minutes West 3.18 chains to iron pin; thence North 86 degrees West 13.09 chains to stone; thence South 26 degrees 30 minutes West 1.53 chains to stone; thence North 63 degrees 30 minutes West 17.10 chains to White oak; thence North 80 degrees West 15 chains to stake; thence South 9 degrees West 7.60 chains to stone; thence South 55 degrees 30 minutes East 1.33 chains to oak; thence South 42 degrees West 6.37 chains to stake; thence South 11 degrees 30 minutes West 2.56 chains to cedar; thence South 67 degrees 30 minutes West 4.80 chains to stake; thence with Reedy River the following courses and distances; south 31 degrees 30 minutes East 4.32 chains; thence South 59 degrees 15 minutes East 10.98 chains; thence South 40 degrees East 10.36 chains; thence South 16 degrees West 10.72 chains; thence South 10 degrees 45 minutes East 10.77 chains; thence South 43 degrees 45 minutes East 15.46 chains; thence North 25 degrees 15 minutes East 6.98 chains; thence North 48 degrees 45 minutes East 11.71 chains; thence North 52 degrees West 7.83 chains; thence North 25 degrees 30 minutes East 10.45 chains; thence North 32 degrees 45 minutes East 9.68 chains; thence South 60 degrees 15 minutes East 2.42 chains to beginning corner.
