## AMORTIZATION MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

*Virginia W. Payne*

Greenville

County and State aforesaid, hereinafter called first party, whether one or more, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, First party is indebted to the Land Bank Commissioner, acting pursuant to Part 3 of the Act of Congress Approved May 12, 1933, known as the Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933, hereinafter called second party, as evidenced by a certain promissory note, of even date herewith, for the principal sum of *One Hundred and no<sup>o</sup> (\$1400.00)* Dollars, payable to the order of the second party, together with interest from the date of said note on the principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid, at the rate of *1% per centum per annum*, the first payment of interest being due and payable on the *First* day of *November*, 1934, and thereafter interest being due and payable annually; said principal sum being due and payable in *Twelve* (12) equal successive annual installments of *One Hundred Forty and no<sup>o</sup> (\$140.00)* Dollars each, and a final installment of *(the same)* Dollars, the first installment of said principal being due and payable on the *First* day of *November*, 1934, and thereafter the remaining installments of principal being due and payable annually until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full; all of which and such other terms, conditions, and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, unto second party, his successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

*All that tract or parcel of land in the County of Greenville, having fifteen and 3/100 (215.35) acres in the town of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as the Virginia W. Payne place located on the Fork Shoals Road ten (10) miles south of Greenville, S.C., on the upland of Red Creek, bounded on the North by land of Griffin Estate, S.C., was bounded on the south by lands of Mrs. R. E. Rainey, and on the east by lands of Mr. G. H. Rainey, and on the west by lands of R. E. Woodard, D. C. Woodard and D. C. Woodard, following metes and bounds and survey and distances recorded to a plat made by C. P. Tuckerman, S.C., Surveyor, on the tenth day of October 1933 to the writer, *Lydia W. Payne*, in the tenth year of the reign of King George VI, A.D. 1933.*

*Beginning at a point in the center of the Fork Shoals Road at the intersection of a road leading to Mrs. Rainey's Dairy and runs thence north 31 degrees 20 minutes west 433 feet to the center of Fork Shoals Road corner St. Albans School, north 81 degrees 20 minutes East 400 feet to stake corner St. Albans School, thence south 32 degrees 00 minutes East 95 feet to iron pin on edge of road to old St. Albans School, thence north 82 degrees 35 minutes East 650 feet to iron pin on edge of road Mrs. Rainey's line, thence south 67 degrees 10 minutes west 500 feet to iron pin in center of Fork Shoals Road corner of Mrs. Rainey and O'Dell, thence south 78 degrees 45 minutes west 825 feet to stake O'Dell's corner, thence north 82 degrees 35 minutes West 1160 feet to iron pin on edge of Griffins and Washington, thence south 25 degrees 40 minutes West 1200 feet to iron pin on branch Griffins corner, thence south 69 degrees 50 minutes East 85 feet to iron pin center of old road Griffins corner, thence south 50 degrees 07 minutes West 145 feet to white oak stump, Griffins corner, thence south 26 degrees 07 minutes West 410 feet to iron pin Griffins corner, thence north 69 degrees 00 minutes West 85 feet to stake corner of branch Griffins corner, thence south 28 degrees West 365 feet with AND CATCHES THE CREEK creek Griffins corner, thence south 16 degrees 30 minutes West 500 feet to iron pin old run of creek Griffins corner, thence south 20 degrees 15 minutes West 135 feet to iron pin Griffins corner, thence south 45 degrees 15 minutes West 547 feet to iron pin Griffins corner, thence south 61 degrees 15 minutes West 160 feet to rock Griffins and Wood corner, thence south 2 degrees 50 minutes East 633 feet to Wood and Woodside corner, thence south 53 degrees 15 minutes East 610 feet to rock Woodside corner, thence north 86 degrees 45 minutes East 246 feet to rock Woodside corner, thence north 63 degrees 45 minutes East 132 feet to center Reedy Fork Creek Woodside and Scott corner, thence North 135 degrees 25 minutes West 87 feet to stake center creek Scott corner, thence north 16 degrees 20 minutes East 1046 feet to rock Scott corner, thence north 78 degrees 50 minutes East 2153 feet to iron pin on edge of road Scott corner Gingles line, thence North 11 degrees 35 minutes East 890 feet to center Farm Road Gingles corner, thence north 72 degrees 40 minutes East 46 feet center of said road, thence north 81 degrees 40 minutes East 448 feet center of said road, thence north 89 degrees 25 minutes 3315 feet to the beginning corner.*
