NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, unto second party, his successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

All that tract or parcel of land containing Forty-Seven and 15/100 (47.15) acres, in Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, known as the Bramlett place, located on a cross country road, 6 miles from Greenville, on waters of Rocky Creek, bounded on the north by lands of aphraim Hudson; on the east by lands of Hugh Wood; on the south by lands of Clarence Wilson; on the west by lands of J. C. Jones, and having the following courses and distances according to survey and plat by J. O. Williams, Surveyor, June 12, 1926.
