Dollars, to be paid One year from date

with interest thereon, from dated 1931 at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of three per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

S. A. Morris at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said P. F. Burketon, the following described property, to wit:

All that certain lot of land situate in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the south side of Rose Ave. known and designated as lot #12 Block "24" of the ~~Staggs~~ Springs Bank Company subdivision, according to a plat made by Dalton & Neely, Engrs., 1925. Said lot having a frontage on the south side of Rose Ave. of 70.1 feet and a depth of approximately 128 feet.
Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by P. D. Craft
and wife dated October 13, 1932, recorded in the P. M. C.
for Greenville County in Deed Book 160 at page 296.
Also,

All that certain lot of land situate in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Ward 1 located on Goodlett Alley (known now as "My Alley"), containing one acre one-fourth (1 $\frac{1}{4}$) acres more or less, and being bounded as follows: on the north by property now or formerly owned by Susie O'Dell and Geo. J. Surrill, on the east by property owned by Emma Maxwell, a. k. a. Davis and J. L. Gross, on the south by property of J. Long and M. Cherry; on the west by said Goodlett Alley.
