

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN No. 32408

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed by Edgeworth M. Blythe to The Penn Mutual Life Insurance Company of Philadelphia, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, State of South Carolina dated September 1, 1922 and recorded in said County on September 11, 1922 in Volume 42 of Mortgages Page 427 the sum of Twenty three Hundred and Seventy five Dollars, with interest from March 1, 1937; and,

WHEREAS, title to the above mentioned real estate is now vested in Edgeworth M. Blythe subject to said mortgage; and,

WHEREAS, the Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided:-

NOW THEREFORE, the Insurance Company hereby extends the time of payment of said note so that it shall be due and payable as hereinafter provided, and said Edgeworth M. Blythe hereby agree, jointly and severally, to pay the principal sum remaining due, as aforesaid, as follows:

\$75.00 semi-annually on the first days of September and March, commencing September 1, 1937, balance five years from date, with the privilege of paying any amount not in excess of 20% of the balance due on any interest paying date

with interest thereon from March 1, 1937 until said principal shall be fully paid, at the rate of five per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to the above extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.

IT IS AGREED that the Statute of Limitations shall not begin to run against the note or said mortgage before the end of said extended period.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the said Edgeworth M. Blythe have hereunto set their hands and seals and the said Insurance Company has caused these presents to be executed in its corporate name by its Assistant to the President, and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed this 17th day of February 1937.
