Whereas, by a certain <sup>Resignation</sup> Deed of Trust, dated September 1st, 1929 and recorded the 14th day of November, 1929 in Book 183, Page 176, in the Office of the Register of Mortg. Conveyance, Greenville County, South Carolina, Linton Barber, conveyed to South Carolina National Bank, Greenville, South Carolina, and Union Trust Company of Maryland, Trustees, the property therein described, to secure a certain indebtedness set out in said Deed of Trust; and

Now, Therefore, This Instrument Witnesseth: That the undersigned Union Trust Company of Maryland, a corporation, does hereby decline and refuse to act as one of the Trustees designated in said Deed of Trust and as Depository; and does hereby resign as such Trustee and as Depository.
