Resignation

Whereas, by a certain Deed of Trust, dated August 1st, 1930, and recorded the 12th day of November, 1930 in Book 183, Page 217, in the Office of the Register of Deeds Conveyance, Greenville County, South Carolina, Lewis Barber conveyed to, South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville S. C., and Union Trust Company of Maryland, Trustees, the property therein described, to secure a certain indebtedness set out in said Deed of Trust; and
