Resignation

Whereas, by a certain Deed of Trust, dated October 15th 1930 and recorded the 30th day of January, 1931 in Book 183, Page 232, in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Meigs County, South Carolina, Lewis Barber conveyed to Madison Marine and Union Trust Company of Maryland, Trustees, the property therein described, to secure a certain indebtedness set out in said Deed of Trust; and

Whereas, Union Trust Company of Maryland is designated as Depository by the terms of said Deed of Trust or has been acting as said Depository for the payments made by the borrower under said Deed of Trust; and

Now, therefore, This Instrument witnesseth: That the undersigned Union Trust Company of Maryland, a corporation, do hereby decline and refuse to act as one of the Trustees designated in said Deed of Trust and as Depository; and do hereby resign as such Trustee and as Depository.
