MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

WHEREAS, I. Frederick Sails

SEND GREETINGS:

in and by me certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, and well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of One Thousand Dollars and no/00 (\$1,000.00) Dollars, and have subscribed to shares of the Instalment Thrift Stock of said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., and have agreed to pay therefor at the rate of Fifty (50) Cents per share, per month, until said payments, plus dividends, have reached the par value of One Hundred Dollars per share, at which time said note shall become due and payable, with interest, and

WHEREAS said note provides for the payment of interest on the sum of \$----- Dollars, at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly, in advance, until maturity of said shares of Instalment Thrift Stock in said Association, and I am desirous of securing said debt and interest:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said I. Frederick Sails

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me, the said I. Frederick Sails in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property, to-wit:

with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments

of Thirty days)

(\$30.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid. Any payment made prior to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any holder of the note, or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, he may foreclose his right with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the trustees of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note, for a reasonable attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collected in a suit therefor, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if it be a debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by a law process, or in any kind of court of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by said note reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon, etc. to be constructed thereon, situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, a short distance within of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, at the southeast corner of Mt. View Avenue and Sowees Street extension and being known and designated as Lot no. 1 of Block 6, of the First Ward as shown by a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in that book C, at page 10, and waving the following waters and boundaries, to wit:

"Beginning at a stake on the southeast intersection of Mountain View Avenue and Sowees Street extension and running thence along Mt. View Avenue S. 80-15 E. 200 feet to a stake on corner of land belonging to Phillip J. Butler; thence along the line S. 9-45 W. 91 feet to a corner post, thence N. 80-15 W. 200 feet to a iron post on Sowees Street, thence along Sowees Street N. 9-45 E. 91 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me by H. L. French by deed dated August 4, 1925 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol 103, page 199"
