MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

WHEREAS, J. M. Horne the said J. M. Horne

SEND GREETINGS:

in and by J. M. Horne certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, one well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of Two Thousand Six Hundred and Ninety (\$2600.00) Dollars, and have subscribed to shares of the Instalment Thrift Stock of said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., and have agreed to pay therefor at the rate of Fifty (50) Cents per share, per month, until said payments plus dividends, have reached the par value of One Hundred Dollars per share, at which time said note shall become due and payable, with interest, and

WHEREAS said note provides for the payment of interest on the sum of \$2600.00 Dollars, at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly, in advance, until maturity of said shares of Instalment Thrift Stock in said Association, and am desirous of securing said debt and interest:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That J. M. Horne, the said J. M. Horne

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further

sum of Three Dollars to J. M. Horne, the said J. M. Horne in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property, to-wit:

with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of Twenty Six and 26/100, ad \$26.00 Dollars upon the last day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, and all other expenses, including costs of collection, shall be paid to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid principal sum to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time, the amount due and unpaid for a period of three months or more, the same calendar shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days or more, then the same may be foreclosed by any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the terms and conditions contained in the amount due under said note, shall at the option of the holder thereof, become irredeemable and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due, and to be collected as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney or collector, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situated in the ~~City~~ ^{part} of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 19, and being the northeastern portion thereof, according to a plat of Sans Souci Villa, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, pages 510-511, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Franklin Road, first corner late fig. road 20, which point is approximately 16 8' feet from the intersection of Franklin Road and Marshall Street, and running the same with line of Lot 20, S. 57-25 E. 159 feet to an iron pin thence N. 32-35 W. 70 feet to an iron pin: thence N. 57-25 W. 159 feet to an iron pin on Franklin Road, which point is 14 feet from the corner of Lots 18 and 19; thence along the south east side of Franklin Road N. 32-35 E. 70 feet to the point of beginning. Being the same lot conveyed to me by Mechanic's Building and Loan Association by deed dated March 19, 1928, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 116, page 306.
