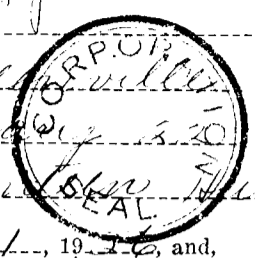


AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 1642321

WHEREAS, There now remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by A. G. Huffy

to The Prudential Life Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County,

dated February 11th, 1936, recorded in said County on February 20th, 1936, in Volume of Books 171 on Page 35, the sum of Seventy Five Dollars, with interest from January 1, 1936, and,



WHEREAS, Title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in A. G. Huffy, and,

WHEREAS, The said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, The said A. G. Huffy

hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

beginning on the 1st day of January, 1936, and on each day in each succeeding year thereafter the sum of \$40.00 and the balance of said principal sum being payable January 1, 1936.

In accepting this extension agreement, the Prudential Insurance Company of America does not substitute the obligations of the signers hereof for the obligations of the original maker of the proposed note, nor does it intend to release the said original maker. The liability of every signer hereof is additional to the liability of the original maker and is intended to be joint and several with them.

with interest thereon from January 1, 1936, at the rate of five and one-half percent per annum, payable annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE: Privilege is given to make additional payments of \$100.00 or any multiple thereof on the principal of said note on any interest due date.

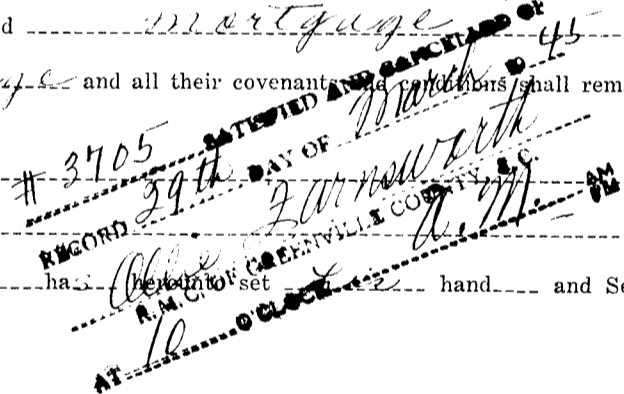
And the owner will keep the buildings upon the mortgaged real estate insured in such forms of insurance as may be required by the mortgage in insurance companies and in amount satisfactory to the mortgagee, and the policies shall contain all proper clauses for the protection of the mortgagee. If the owner shall fail to perform the above agreement the mortgagee may declare the mortgage in default with the same appropriate penalties as heeled in the mortgage for other defaults, and may effect said insurance and all money paid therefor with interest at the penalty rate stated in said mortgage shall be secured by and collectible under said mortgage.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
