

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 141797-4

WHEREAS, There now remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by J. E. Stuckey, Jr.

to The Prudential Life Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated October 29th, 1936, recorded in said County on October 30, 1936, in Volume 171 of Mortgages on Page 38, the sum of Five Thousand and no/100 (\$5,000.00) Dollars, with interest from October 29, 1936, and,

WHEREAS, Title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in J. E. Stuckey, Jr.

subject to said mortgage, and, WHEREAS, The said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, The said J. E. Stuckey, Jr.

hereby agrees to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows: The sum of \$125.00 to be paid on principal on the 29th day of January, 1937, and the sum of \$125.00 on the 29th day of April, July, October and January of each year thereafter up to and including the 29th day of July, 1946, and the balance then remaining due on the 29th day of October, 1946.

with interest thereon from October 29th, 1936, to October 29th, 1946, at the rate of five and one-half per cent. per annum, payable quarterly, and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given to make payments of \$100.00 or any multiple thereof, on the principal sum remaining due of said note, on any interest due date, provided at least thirty days prior to the making of such additional payment, notice shall have been given in writing to the holder hereof of the intention to make such payment.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.

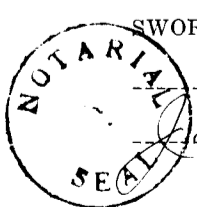
