Now, therefore it is mutually agreed by and between said H. R. Townes as mortgagor, and Hattie D. Smith as mortgagee, that the said sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars, which the said H. R. Townes acknowledges to be owing, shall bear interest at seven per cent, payable semi-annually from July 9, 1934, and the said mortgage shall be renewed and continued from the date of this instrument.
