All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about one-half mile northeast of Sheepfold Court House, S. C. containing the following metes and bounds:

Beginning on the west side of Buncombe Road at the intersection of said road and Neely Avenue and running thence along the north side of Neely Ave. (about) S. 76 1/2 E. 106 feet (to iron pin); thence northwesterly parallel with Buncombe Road 100 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in line of W. B. McAlister lot (beginning corner being 106 feet from the east side of Buncombe Road), thence along McAlister line (about) N. 84 1/2 W. 106 feet to an iron pin on Buncombe Road; thence along Buncombe Road S. 11 3/4 W. 81 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner. This lot is owned by said W. R. Neely and was conveyed to him by Clara V. McBrorey, by deed dated April 26, 1905, recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book 000, page 189.
