SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, the said Ella Francis, in and by my certain promise, in writing, of even date with these presents, to Taylor's Lumber Co., well and truly indebted to Taylor's Lumber Co., in the full and just sum of One and one-half Dollars, and Fifteen and Nine-tenths (157.09) Dollars, to be paid One year from the date of this instrument, satisfied, paid, and accounted for, at the rate of 10% per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually, with interest thereon from the date of this instrument, until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$10.00, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Ella Francis, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Taylor's Lumber Co., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Ella Francis, in hand well and truly paid by the said Taylor's Lumber Co.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Taylor's Lumber Co.:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Furman Hall Road, and being a portion of Tract No. 4 of the property of J. C. Hall, as shown on plat thereof made by R. E. Dalton, Dec. 1916, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Furman Hall Road at a point 314 feet from the intersection of Furman Hall Road with Chick Springs Road, and running thence along the line of said Furman Hall Road S. 28-15 W. 125 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot of E. B. Faister; thence along the line of said E. B. Faister S. 53-40 E. 300 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 28-15 E. 125 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of lot of Estelle Parham; thence along the line of said lot N. 58-40 W. 300 feet to an iron pin on Furman Hall Road, the beginning corner.
