SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, Jesse E. Whatley, Jr., the said Promisor, do now promise to pay to Peoples National Bank as Trustee for Hartense Risenfield, in the full and just sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) Dollars, to be paid on or before one year after date of this note, to wit, January 26, 1901, plus interest thereon, from and including the day of the making of this note, at the rate of six per cent. per annum to be computed and paid until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee.

Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due of the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Jesse E. Whatley, do make and execute this instrument, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Peoples National Bank, as Trustee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

Jesse E. Whatley, in hand well and truly paid by the said Peoples National Bank, as Trustee for Hartense Risenfield

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Peoples National Bank as Trustee for Hartense Risenfield, its successors, heirs and assigns,

All that certain tract of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 10 1/2 acres, more or less, described in the deed of J. E. Dorrestor to R. A. Whatley, deed dated January 26, 1901, recorded in Deed Books XX, page 447, R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County. This said tract of land lies on the branch waters of Hilder's Creek, waters of Enoree River, about seven miles from Greenville Court House, and is bounded by L. & W. C. Railroad, Sallie Bramlett land, A. R. Smith land, and J. E. Dorrestor Estate.

This is the same land conveyed to me, said Jesse E. Whatley by the heirs of said R. A. Whatley, his deed of even date herewith.
