SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said B. L. Parkman, Jr.,
in and by my certain assent, do owe, note, in writing, of
even date with these presents,

to H. P. Mc Gee and B. M. Mc Gee, Trustees,
in the full and just sum of five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)
Dollars, to be paid one year after date of this note,

with interest thereon, from date, at the rate of 7% per annum to be
computed and paid semi-annually,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
 sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10%.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will
more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said B. L. Parkman,
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said H. P. Mc Gee and
B. M. Mc Gee, Trustees,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said
B. L. Parkman,

in hand well and truly paid by the said H. P. Mc Gee and
B. M. Mc Gee, Trustees,
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said H. P. Mc Gee and B. M. Mc Gee, Trustees, their
successors and assigns forever:

All that certain piece parcel or tract of
land in Chick Springs Township Greenville County
State of South Carolina, on the Turnau Hall Road
and being a portion of tract no 4 of the property
of J. C. Hall, as shown on plat thereof made by
A. E. Dalton Dec 1916, and having the following metes
and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection
of Turnau Hall Road and Chick Springs Road, on
the east side of Turnau Hall Road, and running
thence along the line of said Turnau Hall Road,
S. 28-15 W. 109 feet to a wooden pin, corner lot of
J. W. Parkman; thence along the line of the lot
of J. W. Parkman S. 53-0 E. 390 feet to an iron
pin, rear corner lot of J. W. Parkman; thence N.
6-30 E. 109 feet to a stone near Chick's Spring Road,
thence N. 53-0 W. 345 feet to an iron at the
intersection of Turnau Hall Road and Chick
Springs Road, the beginning corner.
