The Citizens Lumber Company, a Corporation, its successors and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Part 1 of the City of Greenville, on the east side of Pine Street and Beginning at a stake on Pine Street at the corner of E.L. Hawk's lot and running thence in a northerly direction with Pine Street, 64 feet to a stake at the corner of lot formerly owned by G.S. Norwood; thence with the line of said lot in an easterly direction parallel, or approximately so, with King Street, 14 8/2 feet to stake at corner of lot formerly owned by W.H. Irvine; thence with line of last mentioned lot in a southerly direction, 67 1/2 feet to stake at corner of Hawk's lot; thence with line of Hawk's lot in a westerly direction, 18 3/2 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to Horace Dillard and Ellen Dillard by Jessie E.
