 and release unto the said J. I. Thomason, the following described pro-
 perty, to wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina in Butler Township, on the West side of the Roper Mountain Road containing 12.81 Acres, more or less, known and designated as Tract # 4 of the property of E. G. Green and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the Roper Mountain Road corner of Adams property and running thence N. 37-30 W. 373 feet to a stone corner of Watson property; thence S. 60-40 W. 480 feet to a Locust; thence S. 45-30 W. 307 feet to a stone; thence S. 6 E. 105.5 feet to a stone; thence S. 22 W. 160 feet to a stake; thence S. 48 W. 340 feet to an iron pin corner of Simmons property; thence S. 43-10 E. 317 feet to pin; thence N. 49-50 E. 982 feet to pin on said Roper Mountain Road; thence with said road N. 32-45 E. 307 E. 307 feet to the beginning corner, Being the same tract of land conveyed to us by E.
