WHEREAS, I, G. A. Neal, the said G. A. Neal, in and by my certain Promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, S.C. as Trustee for Bernice Eundel, in the full and just sum of One hundred and five Thousand, \$105,000.00 plus interest, Dollars, to be paid as follows: \$500.00 January 3, 1936; \$500.00 January 3, 1937; \$500.00 January 3, 1938; \$500.00 January 3, 1939 and \$500.00 January 3, 1940, with the proviso of anticipating the payment of the whole or any part thereof on any interest bearing date. Paid this sixteenth day of January 1936 at the rate of ten per cent. per annum to be computed and paid. full until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent., besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part hereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, S.C. as Trustee for Bernice Eundel, the following described property to wit: All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in the city of Greenville on the North side of Earle St., known as the Southeast quarter of lot # 9 on a plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "E" at Page 157, and having the following metes and bounds to wit:
