sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said Sallie McGowan, her heirs and assigns forever;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in Highland Township,
Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Beginning on a stake on H. G. Barton's line on Pax Creek, thence up said creek N.
27 W. 17. chains to bend in said creek; thence N. 8 W. 6.80 ch. to a bend; thence N. 41
E. 3.50 ch. to a bend; thence S. 67 E. 2.30 ch. to a hickory corner on the South Bank of
Pax Creek; thence S. 47 E. 8.08 ch. to a stone; thence N. 71 E. 13.00 ch. to a stone; thence
S. 26 E. 27.50 ch. to red oak; thence N. 75 W. 10.80 chains to the head of the branch;
thence along the said branch as a line with H. G. Barton's line to a stake on Pax Creek about
23.00 ch. to the beginning corner, and containing Forty-Five acres, more or less.
