KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, Edgar S. Burgen, of the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, and hereinafter known and designated as Mortgagor, whether one or more.

WHEREAS, the mortgagor stands indebted unto HOME OWNERS' LOAN CORPORATION, a Corporation created under Section 4 of an Act of Congress of the United States of America, known as Home Owners' Loan Act of 1933, approved June 13, 1933, with its principal place of business in the City of Washington, in the District of Columbia, in the United States of America hereinafter known and designated mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, for the full and just principal sum of Two Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$2,000.00) payable to the order of the mortgagee, together with interest thereon from the date at the rate of 6% per annum (6%) per annum on the balance remaining from time to time unpaid, both principal and interest being payable on an amortization plan in monthly installments of \$17.99 per month on the first day of each and every month hereafter, the payments being applied, first, to interest on unpaid balances, and the remainder to principal until said debt is paid in full. Extra payments may be made on the due date of any installment, and interest will be charged only on the balance of said debt remaining unpaid. All of which, and such other terms and conditions as contained in said note, will fully appear by reference thereto; default in payment of any installment of principal and interest for a period of ninety (90) days to render the whole debt due at the option of the mortgagee.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the mortgagor, in consideration of the said debt and the sum of money aforesaid and for the better security of the payment thereof, the said mortgagee, according to the terms of the said note and of this mortgage, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the said mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee at and before the signing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, in fee simple, and these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release, in fee simple, unto the mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described land, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, or to be erected thereon, situate, lying and being:

On the Southern side of Arden Street, a short distance east of the City of Greenville, in Greenville Township, in the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, being shown and delineated also Lots No's 65 and 62 in the plat of "Eastover" made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, July 1920, and recorded in Plat Book No. 42, being divided as follows: On the North side of Arden Street, on the East by Lots No's 64 and 53 now and formerly owned by J. B. League, on the South by Gara Street, and on the West by Lots No's 66 and 51 now or formerly owned by R. E. Dalton; and when delineated together showing the following notes and bounds, beginning at a given point, corner of Lot No. 64, and running thence with the lines of Lots No's 64 and 51, S 30 E, 300 feet to an iron pin at Gara Street, thence with the Northern side of Gara Street, S. 64-30 N. 60 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 51, thence with the lines of Lots No's 51 and 66, S. 25 E. 300 feet to a point on Arden Street, thence with the Southern side of Arden Street, N. 64-30 E. 60 feet to the beginning of said premises being that conveyed to Edgar S. Burgen by J. B. League by deed dated October 4, 1924, and recorded in the Public Office for Greenville County, on October 6th, 1924, in Book of Deeds "92" at Page 551.
