All that certain piece or tract of land in Saluda Township County and State aforesaid, and runs as follows. Beginning at mouth of branch on Emma Guest line, thence up said branch 10.50 chains to the Buncombe road, thence S. 72 1/2 W. with said road 10.50 chains to a settlement road, thence S. 6 E. 2 chains to a bend, thence S. 14 E. 2.38 to a bend, thence S. 35 E. 3.80 to a bend, thence S. 35 E. 3.80 to a Locust on river, thence down the river 7.60 to a small maple, thence S. 41 1/2 E. 33.40 to a stone, thence N. 48 1/2 E. 7.20 to chestnut Oak, thence N. 41 1/2 W. 28.50 to a stone on river, thence up the river to the beginning and containing $32 \frac{1}{2}$ acres.
