 WHEREAS, I, the said John P. Harrison and Ivey Poole  
in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to South Carolina National  
Bank, a corporation  
in the full and just sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00)  
Dollars, to be paid on the first day of December, 1936

with interest from Sept. 1, 1935 at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid The South Carolina National Bank  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of  
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder

ten per cent., besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
paid to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,  
reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

 #1 On the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do  
 grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said South Carolina National Bank,  
 a corporation, its successors and assigns:  
 All those two certain parcels or lots of land  
 situate and lying in the Town of Greer, County  
 of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, South  
 Carolina, fronting on Cunningham Avenue and  
 Pine Street (formerly Spring Street), and more par-  
 ticularly described on a plat of the Lelia M. Cunningham  
 property, prepared by W. A. Christopher, Surveyor, September  
 13, 1921, which plat is recorded in Plat Book "F", at page  
 17, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, same being lots nos.  
 34 and 35 as described thereon, and having the follow-  
 ing courses and distances: Beginning on Cunningham  
 Avenue at an iron pin, at the joint corners of lots 33  
 and 34, and running thence N. 27° 00' E. 75 feet to joint  
 corners of lots 23 and 26; thence N. 70° 00' E. 109.3 feet to an  
 iron pin on Pine Street; thence N. 25° 45' E. 75 feet to an iron pin  
 joint corners of lots 35 and 26; thence S. 70° E. 193 feet to joint  
 corners of lots 24 and 26; thence S. 27° 30' E. 150 feet to an iron  
 pin on Cunningham Avenue; thence N. 70° E. 85 feet to the be-  
 ginning corner.

Also, all that other parcel or lot of land adjoining the  
 above described lots, and being all of lot no. 33 as described on  
 the plat above referred to, having the following courses and  
 distances, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the corner of in-  
 tersection of Pine Street and Cunningham Avenue and running thence  
 N. 70° E. 107.3 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot no. 34; thence N. 27°  
 E. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 70° E. 109.3 feet to an iron  
 pin in Pine Street; thence S. 26° 45' E. 75 feet to the beginning corner.  
 The above described property are the identical lots of land con-  
 veyed to us by Carlile C. Landford by her deed of July 3, 1935, re-  
 corded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 180, page  
 338; also, deed to us from Planters Saving Bank, as Executor, dated
