I, C. J. White

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said C. J. White  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

Citizens Lumber Company  
in the full and just sum of Seven Hundred (\$700.00) Dollars,

to be paid Twenty five (\$25.00) dollars, a month, interest to be deduct-  
ed out of the monthly payments, and the remainder  
credited on the principal, first payment to be made September  
7, 1935 and thereafter \$25.00 on the 7th day of each succeeding  
month until paid in full with interest thereon, from date, at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid semi-annually in advance

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of  
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the  
holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent of the payment due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said  
debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the  
the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said C. J. White

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Citizens Lumber Co.  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to

the said Citizens Lumber Co.  
in hand well and truly paid by the said C. J. White  
at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Lumber Company.

That certain parcel, lot or tract  
of good situate, being in Greenville  
Township, Greenville County, State aforesaid, being  
two tracts of land adjoining each other, about three  
and one-half miles from Greenville Court House, S.  
C., and adjoining McGowan High School.

Tract no. 1, known as tract no. 4-a on plat of  
Young Land, has the following metes and bounds:  
Beginning at the intersection of 30-foot road and  
White Horse Road, and thence running with White  
Horse Road, S. 34-55 E. 261.5 feet to stake; thence  
N. 68-05 E. 610-4 feet to center of said 30-foot road;  
thence with said road N. 58-33 E. 241.8 feet to  
stake; thence with road S. 74-44 E. 527.1 feet to  
the beginning corner, containing two and 87/100  
(2.87) acres, more or less, and being the same  
land conveyed to C. J. White by Elsie Ramey  
February 28, 1928, by deed recorded in Volume 127,  
page 127, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

Tract no. 2 known as tract no. 5, on said plat  
has the following metes and bounds: Beginning  
in center of White Horse Road, at corner of tract  
no. 4-a, thence running N. 68-05 E. 610.4 feet to  
center of 30 foot road, thence with road S. 58-33 E.  
250 feet to corner of tract no. 6; thence S. 64-35 E.  
805.6 feet to center of White Horse Road; thence with  
White Horse Road N. 34-55 E. 250 feet to the beginning  
corner containing three and forty-six one-hundredths  
(3.46) acres, and being the same lot conveyed to  
C. J. White by Lena C. Collins, by deed dated December  
10, 1928, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County in Volume 136, page 421.
