Sell that certain tract of land situate in Greenville County, South Carolina, and in Dunklin Township, on a branch of the southwesterly tributary of Mountain Creek, waters of Saluda River, and a branch of the east tributary of Horse Creek, waters of Reedy River, containing one hundred and eighty (180) acres, more or less, the greater portion of same being the Archibald Ramsay tract, and 17.6 acres being of another tract, the entire 180 acres lying in one body, and being described as follows: Beginning at a stone 3x (old mark) at the northeast corner; thence S. 62 1/2 W. 31.37 to a pine sapling 3x (new mark) in the old railroad cut; thence S. 68-9/10 W. 20.35 to a stake 3x (new mark) south of the branch; bounded on these two lines by a tract this day conveyed to R.
