Dollars, to be paid on March 8, 1938, at the date of Rogers' birth  
with interest thereon, from date of note at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of  
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ~~one-half cent~~

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said ~~Lessie Rogers, as Guardian for Jeanne Turner~~,

That lot of land in Ward Six of the City of Greenville  
in state and county aforesaid, beginning at corner  
of lot of J. P. Chapman and running thence with  
line of Chapman lot N. 74-45 W. 99.5 feet to iron pin;  
thence N. 15-15 E. 19.5 feet to a stake, at corner of lot of  
Susie Reed; thence with line of said lot S. 74-45 E.  
53 feet to a stake, corner Susie Reed lot. thence  
with line of said lot N. 15-15 E. 20.5 feet to stake in  
line of Susie Reed lot; thence along other property  
of Susan Harrison S. 74-45 E. 46.5 feet to stake on
