WHEREAS, I, *N. P. Aiken*, the said *N. P. Aiken*

Dollars, to be paid *three years after date*

with interest thereon from *the date of this* at the rate of *10%* percent, per annum to be
computed and paid *in full and the lien of this* instrument is satisfied this *19 41*
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid when the whole amount evidenced by said note
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten (10%) per cent*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will
more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, *N. P. Aiken* the said *N. P. Aiken*
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said
Miss Daisy Mae
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me* the said
N. P. Aiken

in hand well and truly paid by the said
Miss Daisy Mae
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said *Miss Daisy Mae*

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
in the Town of West Greenville on the north side
of Pendleton St., being designated as Lot no. 22 of
the lands of Furman and Haynesworth, bounded
on the East by Lot no. 23, heretofore conveyed by
Davis Furman and H. J. Haynesworth to Scruggs
and on the West by Lot no. 21 heretofore conveyed
by Davis Furman and H. J. Haynesworth to
Davenport, fronting fifty feet on Pendleton Road
with a depth of One Hundred ninety six feet, more or
less, to line of alley as laid out on plat of said
lands.

The above described lot of land is the same
as was conveyed to me by Heber J. Grant, Trustee,
by his deed dated Nov. 24, 1926 and recorded in
the P. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C. in
Book 113, page 51, and likewise being the same
conveyed to the said Grant as Trustee by A. Von
Hollen by his deed dated March 25, 1921 and
recorded in the office of the P. M. C. for Greenville
County, S. C. in Book 62, page 35."
