NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Mary E. Keith

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Lumber Company, its successors, heirs and assigns

all that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

On the south side of Ashley Avenue, known and designated as lot No. 18 on plat of property of B.E. Keer made by Dalton & Neves, October, 1930, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, page 177, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Ashley Avenue, joint corner of lots nos. 18 and 19, and running thence along the joint line of lots nos. 18 and 19, S. 24-30 W. 200 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots nos. 18 and 19, thence S. 65-30 E. 55 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots nos. 17 and 18, thence along the joint line of lots nos. 17 and 18 N. 24-30 E. 200 feet to an iron pin in the south side of Ashley Avenue; thence along the south side of Ashley Avenue, N. 65-30 W. 55 feet to the point of beginning.
