N. Cleveland to A. M. Beaty, by deed recorded in Deed Book 152, page 518, R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County, and later conveyed by A. M. Beaty to Cherry Investment Company by deed recorded in Deed Book 166, page 215, said R. M. C.
