TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Edna Westbrook Bussey, of Greenville, South Carolina, of the age of 19 years, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:  
 WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston (Columbia Branch), a corporation organized and existing under the laws of United States of America, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Fifty-four hundred and four dollars (\$5400.00), with interest from the first day of February, 1937, at the rate of five per centum (5%) per annum until paid, principal and interest being payable at the office of The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston (Columbia Branch) in Greenville, S. C., in monthly installments of Thirtysix and 7/100s Dollars (\$36.77), commencing on the first day of March, 1937, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the day of February, 1942.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate situated in the county of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with all buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the southwest corner of Farris Road and Argonne Drive, just outside the city of Greenville in Greenville Township, Greenville County, S. C., known and designated as Lot no. 21 of the L. B. Martin subdivision as shown on a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 8, page 102, and having, according to a survey made by Dalton & Nevels December 1936, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the southwest corner of the intersection of Farris Road and Argonne Drive, running thence with the west side of Argonne Drive S. 41-10 E. 204.5 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot no. 22, thence S. 52-19 E. 90.7 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 41-10 W. 233.7 feet to an iron pin on the south side of West Farris Road; thence with the south side of said road N. 69-50 E. 97 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
