NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release

unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate situated in the county of *Greenville*
State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina,
County of Greenville, just outside the corporate limits of
the City of Greenville on the south side of Hillcrest Drive,
being known and designated as Lot 1A on a plat of
property of Hillcrest Section of North Hills, which plat is
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in
Plat Book H. at page 136. And having, according to said
plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of
Hillcrest Drive, joint corner of Lots A and 129, and
running thence along joint line of said lots, S. 29-19
W. 146-8 feet to an iron pin in the north side of Lot 1;
thence along line of Lot 1 S. 66-21 E. 44 feet to an iron
pin, joint rear corner of Lots A and B; thence along joint
line of said lots, N. 843-56 E. 137.3 feet to an iron pin
in the south side of Hillcrest Drive, joint corner of
Lots A and B; thence along the south side of Hillcrest
Drive N. 46-21 W. 25.3 feet to an iron pin; thence still
with said Hillcrest Drive N. 58-51 W. 34.7 feet to an
iron pin, the point of beginning, being the same lot
of land conveyed to the mortgagor herein by Central
Agencies Company by deed dated January 31, 1931, and
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in
Deeds Volume 154 at page 74.
