"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situated and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

and in Paris Mountain Town Sept 1st 1937 410397 McFalls and containing 81.70 acres, more or less, and the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake in the center of the intersection of Gibbons road with the road leading to Mr. Robinson's house, and running thence with the last mentioned road 30 21. 281 feet to a stake in the center of said road at W. 15 21. 40 feet to a stake, thence N. 54-45 W. 20 21. 40 feet to a bend; thence N. 64 21. 400 feet to a bend; thence W. 71 feet to stake; thence N. 82-15 W. 34 21. 802 feet to stake; thence N. 44 1/2 21. 1452 feet to a stone, in Saluda Lake; thence with the line of the lake approximately N. 40 E. 1500 feet more or less to a stake in Saluda Lake; thence S. 88 E. 851. 40 feet to a stake, on Arthur McQuinnes corner; thence S 2 1/2 W. 759 feet to a dogwood; thence S. 34 1/4 E. 636. 90 feet to a pine stump; thence S. 42-05 W. 261. 60 feet more or less to Mr. Lemings corner; thence with Lemings line, S. 87-50 E. 1283 feet to a corner in center of Gibbon road (being 103 feet beyond Lemings corner); thence with center of said Gibbon road S. 45 21. 167 feet to bend; thence S. 37 21. 384 feet to bend; thence S. 43-30 W. 751 feet to the beginning corner.
