days from dated this 23rd day of June 1936,
with interest thereon from date at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of such cases, the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 4 at page 124, the said lot being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the joint corner of lots 50 and 51, and running thence with the line of Lot #50 S. 39-33 E. 175 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 47-10 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 39-33 W. 175 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 47-10 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
