All that ~~one~~ piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Chick Spring Township, Greenville County and in the state aforesaid, and located about 3 miles north of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the center of road, which road leads from the Paris Mountain Road to the Rutherford Road thence S. 7½ W. 2.00 to iron pin; thence S. 67½ E. 1.30 to iron pin; thence N. 7½ E. 2.00 to point in center of said road; thence along center of said road, N. 67½ W. 1.30 to point of beginning; this lot lying and being on the south side of said road, and being the same surveyed by W.
