I, Henry Holley SEND GREETINGS:

Whereas, I the said Henry Holley  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am  
well and truly indebted to W. A. Smith

in the full and just sum of Seven Hundred  
(\$ ) Dollars, to be paid one year from date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 7 per centum per annum, to be computed  
annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear  
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount due by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and to enforce this mortgage; and in case said note after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder hereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

W. A. Smith:

Trammell by Samuel Tinsley by deed dated November 5, 1872, and recorded in Vol. "EE", Page 158, in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, S. C., and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, as shown by plat made by W. A. Hester, Surveyor, October 16, 1923:
